

Education Programs Internships at The Art Base

The Art Base is a community art center that fosters creative expression in the visual arts for all ages and abilities through education, exhibitions, and providing opportunities to artists and artisans. Our education programs are designed to be accessible to everyone and encourage creative expression and lifelong learning through all-ages visual arts workshops and outreach programs in partnership with local nonprofits and Basalt schools.

We are currently seeking passionate individuals for Education Programs Summer Internships. These roles are crafted to support the growth of interns while enabling them to make meaningful contributions to the Art Base's programs and operations. Interns will have the opportunity to work alongside experienced art educators, assist with events, maintain classrooms and art studio equipment, handle administrative tasks, and pursue independent projects.

Qualifications and Eligibility: Successful candidates will demonstrate a genuine passion for the arts and enjoy working with students of all ages and abilities.

Eligibility: Internships are open to students entering ninth grade through college who are passionate about and committed to the visual arts. Please note that interns must be at least 15 years old in order to qualify for a paid internship.

Dates: Our 2024 summer workshops will run from June 3rd to August 2nd. With few exceptions, summer workshops are held Monday – Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at The Art Base. Interns are typically expected to work one to three weeks over the summer, depending on their schedules and The Art Base's programmatic needs. Some weekend and evening work may be available, and additional weeks may be possible depending on intern's job performance and availability.

Compensation: Education Programs Interns are compensated \$17/hr for their contributions. Upon successful completion of the program, interns will receive a certificate of completion and a reference from The Art Base for college applications or future employment.

Application: To apply, please email <u>programs@theartbase.org</u>. Applications will be accepted until the positions are filled, and successful candidates will be invited to an in-person meeting at the Art Base. Positions are allocated based on need and availability.
